## Settings Details

### Run Status Report

Choose **'Yes'** to receive a daily summary. It will be sent to the contact you've specified in the Recipients area.

### Time to Run Report

Specify the time to run the report. Selection of times start at midnight and run through the day at half hour intervals. If a time is desired that isn't shown, it can be typed in directly.

### Day of the Week

Select a day to send the report, or choose "All" to send it daily (recommended).

### [Run Report Now] Button

If you wish to test your settings immediately, click the **[Run Report Now]** button.
