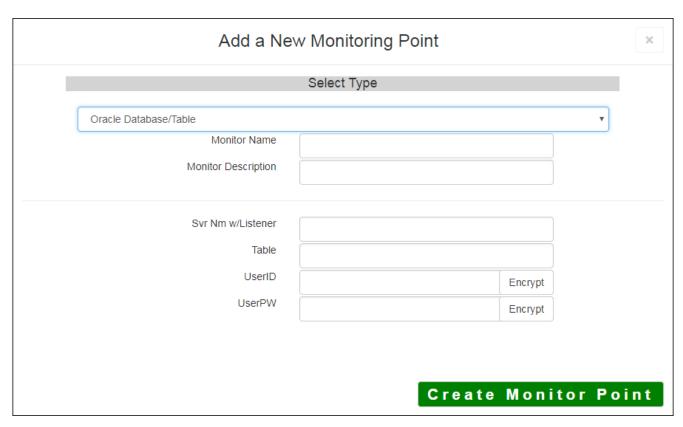
Oracle Database/Table



The Oracle Database/Table monitoring point checks an Oracle Database and Table, if available. The script provides and which is installed locally and configured to perform this check. Make sure that the ORACLE_I system PATH is set to the folder where the Oracle (32Bit) client is located.

The parameters that are unique to the Oracle Database/Table include:

Server Nm w/Listener	Server name, port and listener to connect to the Oracle DB
Server Mili W/Listener	Derver hame, port and insteller to connect to the Oracle DB

Table	Oracle Table to check
userID	User ID with access to the Oracle DB/Table. If using Windows AD authenticat
	Domain\\UserID
	Note: userID should be entered as encrypted information
userPW	User PW for access to the Oracle DB/Table
	Note: userPW should be entered as encrypted information
